Art of Play

a six-month introductory learning of 4 Arts + 1 Tech modules

Dance

Hop, turn and move with confidence and style. The dance module covers dance styles such as Contemporary, Hip Hop and Urban Dance. Children will improve their physical coordination as they progress from basic moves to dancing to a rhythm.

Music

Music notes are as easy as A, B, C in this class. The music module introduces note-reading, rhythm and beats through musical instruments such as the guitar and keyboard. Children will learn to appreciate music with exposure to both classical and modern music.

Visual Arts

Dare to be bold while experimenting with various techniques and mediums. The visual arts module focuses on creative thinking and creating original work. Children will learn elements of art and principles of design in a fun and interactive setting.

Theatre

Einstein once said that imagination is more powerful than knowledge. The theatre module encourages imagination to take flight and come alive. Children will play and portray different characters using body movements, vocal manipulation and facial expressions.

Tech + Arts

A brand new module that brings a convergence of technology and the arts. Children will be introduced to the practical application of more than 10 different digital technologies: Augmented & Virtual Reality, Projection Mapping, 360° Filmmaking and more!

¹Urban dance / ²Ballet

Budding dancers can choose between specialising in one of two dance genres - Urban Dance or Ballet. The Urban Dance programme covers complex footwork, fast-paced music and high energy dance choreography. The Ballet programme follows the Royal Academy of Dance syllabus which challenges children to master more complex ballet techniques.



³Keyboard / ⁴Guitar / ⁵Percussion

Eager musicians can choose to specialise in an instrument – the keyboard, guitar, or percussion. Children will learn about music practical and theory. The programme is geared towards the Trinity College London Music examinations as well as competitions.



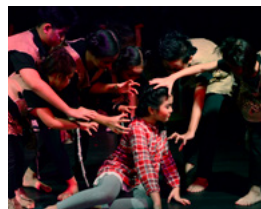
⁶Visual Arts

Budding artists can choose to hone their technical mastery of mediums such as pencils, charcoal and acrylic paint, or learn representational and conceptual art-making through experimentation. Children will create three-dimensional works or artworks on canvas. The programme concludes with an exhibition of the children's best artworks at the end of the year.



⁷Theatre

Young actors will learn how to devise their own plays, read monologues and perform duologues. Children will focus on acquiring techniques in voice projection, characterisation, basic staging and stage presence. The programme is geared towards the London Academy of Music and Dramatic Art or Trinity Guildhall examinations.



⁸Tech + Arts

Harness technology and bring artistic creations to a whole new level of experience! Children will embark on an experiential learning journey to create a project, performance or exhibition infusing digital technologies that have changed the landscape of creative industries.
